Time: From 18.00 hrs

Dress Code: Smart Casual: Respectful dress in Thailand at present is black/grey/white attire i.e. muted colored blouse, polo shirt, trousers, jeans, skirts..

Note: Alternatively the PKCR Committee will provide a black ribbon \*

#### **Royal Prize Giving Ceremony**

Date: Saturday, 10 December 2016

Time: From 17.00 hrs

Venue: Kanda Hall, Kata Beach Resort and Spa

Dress Code: A representative from the Privy Council will be representing the Palace for this event and as such the event is more formal.

All men are required to wear black or white/grey attire i.e. polo shirt and muted colored long trouser are advised. (NO flip-flops, denim, T-shirts are allowed)

Women are required to wear black or white/grey attire i.e. dresses or blouse and muted colored skirts that extend below the knees. (No denim, short skirt, sleeveless shirts or flip-flops are allowed)

Note: If you don't wear black, the PKCR Committee will request you to wear black ribbon \*

\*During regatta events and at other dinner receptions, a black ribbon will be available for participants who wish to join the mourning code
